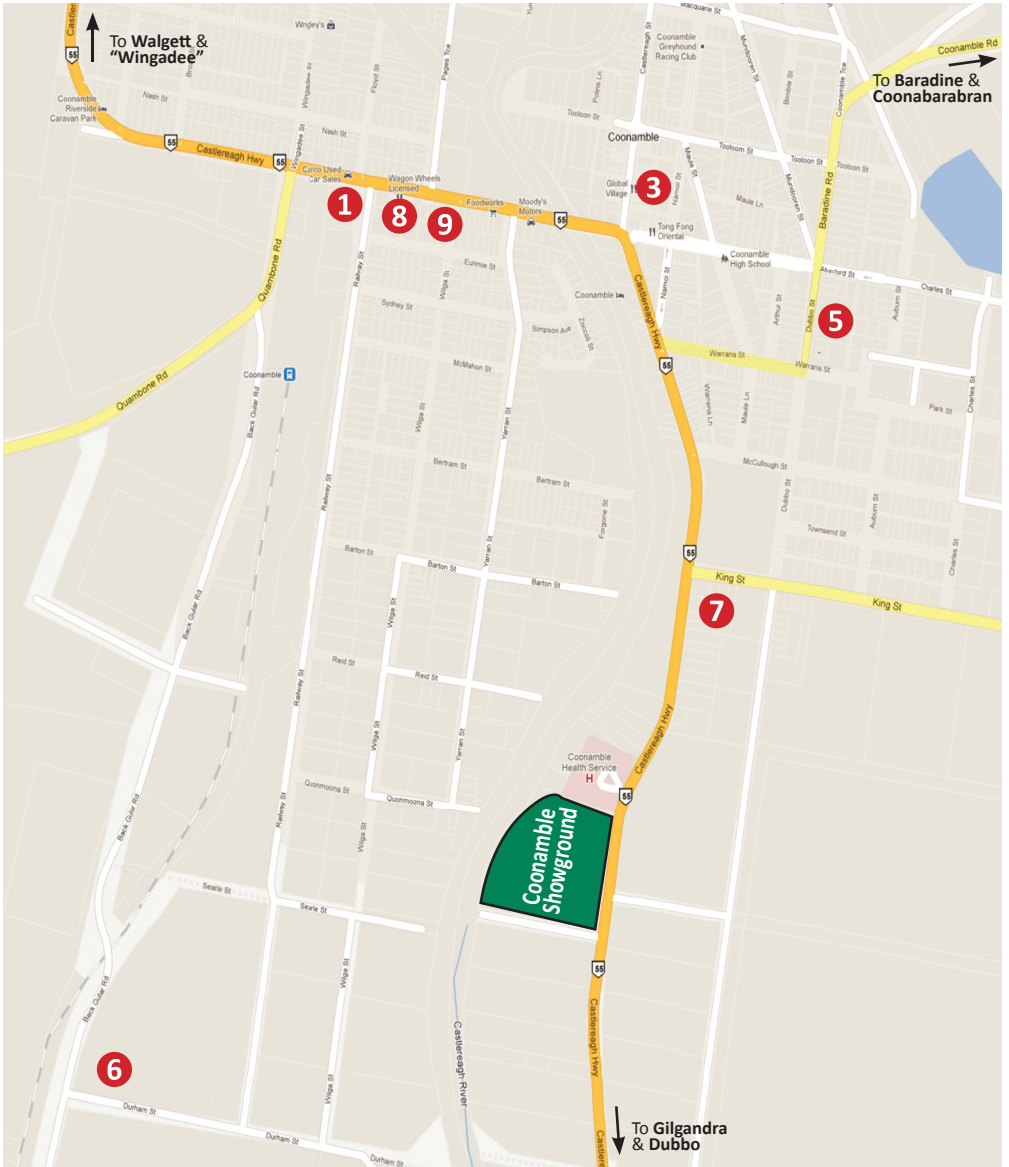

Conditions of Entry

- Cattle under 360kg live weight will not be killed and will not be eligible to compete in hoof or hook competitions.
- Cattle must be at least fat score 3 to be eligible to compete and to be killed.
- Only **milk tooth** steers and heifers are eligible.
- All animals are to be **HGP FREE**
- All animals must be quiet – unruly and unsafe animals may be disqualified at the discretion of the stewards.
- All cattle must be dehorned prior to arrival. Scurs less than 3cm only.
- All livestock must be prepared **on the school farm** for a minimum of seventy days, therefore **MUST** be transferred to the Schools NLIS Data Base and be traveling under the Schools Vendor Declaration.
- All stock must be in control at all times, nose ring/dog at all times and neck chains for tying up.
- All animals must be presented for weighing by **Sam** on Wednesday 26th October accompanied by the appropriate Vendor Declaration. (Consigned to COONAMBLE SHOW GROUNDS)
- All animals are part of the competition and are for sale and will compete in the On the Hook competition. No other animals are allowed on the grounds.
- All schools must have a teacher present on the grounds **at all times** especially if the school is camping overnight.
- The Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
